CONSENT FOR THE TRANSBOUNDARY MOVEMENT OF WASTE FROM LESOTHO TO SOUTH AFRICA: NOTIFICATION No 2023-045

The Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (the Department) as the competent authority for the implementation of the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movement of Hazardous Waste and their Disposal in South Africa hereby acknowledges receipt of the abovementioned notification and its supporting documentation.

The notification concerns the transboundary movement of 100 m³ of used oil from Mosh Group of Companies (Pty) Ltd in Lesotho to Patrick Mofokeng (Pty) Ltd in South Africa for re-refining or other reuses of previously used oil at their facility located on portion 5 of the farm Rietfontein No 107, Bloemfontein within Mangaung Metropolitan Municipality, Free State. According to the notification document the movement of waste is intended to place in 50 loads from December 2023 until January 2024.

Having considered the supporting documents submitted in this respect, the Department, on behalf of the South African government hereby grants permission for the import of the said waste stream provided that the following conditions are met:

- Copy of this permission and the movement document accompanies each shipment of waste;
- Movement documents must be submitted to the Department on Basel@dfpe.gov.za prior to the commencement of the movement operation with the subject title of the email being the notification number as specified above;
- Movement document must be stamped by the waste manager and must be submitted to the Department on completion of the transfer of each consignment; and
- Disposal certificates must be submitted to the Department once the disposal is completed.

This permission **expires** on **09 December 2024**.
